Who can rent with Point A to Point B Rides

To rent a vehicle for rideshare or delivery, you must:

- Be at least 21 years old (drivers 21-24 require 3+ years of licensed driving; 25+ require 1+ year).
- Hold a valid, non-expired U.S. driver's license.
- Have a clean driving record: no more than 3 moving violations in the past 3 years; no DUI/DWI, reckless driving, or license suspension in the past 7 years.
- Pass a background check (consent required). Disqualifiers include felony convictions (7-year lookback), any sexual offense, and serious violent or theft crimes.
- Be approved (or eligible for approval) on your chosen platform (Uber, Lyft, DoorDash, Roadie, or Amazon Flex).
- Provide: driver's license, proof of platform approval or intent, and proof of insurance if using your own coverage.

Selecting one of our rental protection plans is required unless you provide qualifying rideshare-endorsed personal coverage.
